DOMAINE DE CROCHET

Grand Cru Mont-sur-Rolle

Chardonnay 2017

La Côte AOC



92/100

Light straw colour with a green hue. Pure nose high toned with lemongrass, citrus, white fleshed fruit and floral notes. Very good grip on the palate, nicely austere and salivating with discreet savoury fruit, fine extract and a very long, grippy finish.

Excellent purity.

L'OVAILLE « 1584 »

Chasselas 2017

Bright straw colour with some co2. Pure and stony nose with fine layers of pale stone fruit, citrus, wild herbs and floral notes. The palate has good density and grip in a medium body, fresh and salivating with fine extract, discreet fruit flavours, stony and salty with a long pure finish.



LA TORRENTIÈRE

Bright light golden colour with a light fizz. The nose is pure, floral and exotic with ripe yellow fruit, hazelnut, sweet citrus and ginger. Very good grip on the palate, mild acidity but really fine extract and nervy fruit, pure and stony with a long pure finish.

Youthful straw colour with a green hue. Youthful nose with a gentle hint of oak, young fruit, pear, citrus, nuts and some floral notes. The palate is bright and fresh, good zest and grip with pure young fruit flavours, ripe citrus and fine extract with a long finish and well-integrated oak.



CLOS DU CHÂTELARD

Premier Grand Cru Villeneuve

Merlot Apicius 2015

Medium to deep ruby colour. Intense nose, some development, truffle, smoke, sweet red fruit and fine spices. The palate is full but finely rounded with ripe tannin, layers of ripe red fruit with a fine spiciness, approaching maturity and truffle notes with a long finish.

DOMAINE DU MONTET

Grand Cru Bex

Merlot La Lieue 2015

Chablais AOC

Medium deep ruby red colour. Pure, floral and intense nose with violet, cassis, red berries, tobacco, truffle and a light smokiness. The palate is ample and unctuous with smooth texture, layers of spicy fruit with integrated oak and a long warm finish.



DOMAINE DE CROCHET

Premier Grand Cru Mont-sur-Rolle

Merlot 2015

Medium deep ruby red colour. Generous nose, intense aromas of sweet red fruit, vanilla, mild oak, smoke and truffle. The palate is ripe and rounded with savoury red fruit notes underlined by fine oak, a mild spiciness and a long silky finish.

CLOS DE LA GEORGE

Grand Cru Yvorne

Syrah 2016

Medium deep ruby red colour. Intense nose, peppery and spicy with blackberry, cherry, smoked meat, fine oak and floral hints. The palate is dense and youthful yet with ripe extract, savoury red fruit with a bold spiciness and a long finish. Digest and generous fruit, will still improve but already offers pleasure.



DOMAINE DE LA MURAZ

La Torrentière, Sion

Pinot Noir de Sion 2016

Light to medium deep ruby red colour. Floral and fragrant with rose petal, red fruit, ginger, clove, tobacco and mild oak. Medium weight on the palate, fresh and savoury with digest red fruit, a mild spiciness and a long supple finish.

Grand Cru Mont-sur-Rolle

Charles Auguste 2015

La Côte AOC



90/100

Dark ruby red colour. Pure nose, layered with dark fruit like cassis, plum, cherry, pepper, mild spices, tobacco and discreet oak. The palate is dense and weighty with a youthful but ripe texture, layers of spicy dark fruit and a long finish. Potent wine still needing time to develop and soften.



LA TORRENTIÈRE

Sion

Ermitage 2017

Valais AOC



90/100

Bright young straw colour with a light fizz. Pure nose rather stony with floral, nutty and light fruity aromas like green apple, melon, citrus and fresh almond. The palate shows medium weight, a bit more ripeness than the nose suggests, fine extract, a well-balanced acidity, more yellow fruit flavours with stony and nutty notes, and a long and vigorous finish. Discreet but layered with nice texture.

CLOS DE LA GEORGE

Chardonnay 2017

Bright young straw colour. Pure nose, youthful and intense with some new oak, vanilla, butter and pale stone fruit. Nicely restrained palate, a bright freshness, well-integrated oak, juicy citrus and stone fruit flavours with good grip and length.

Merlot 2015

Dense dark purple core and a lighter rim. Pure nose with ripe dark fruit, crushed plum, red currant, dry spices some oak and white pepper. Still youthful palate but balanced with good weight, rather high tannin, and a long and vigorous finish. A wine still needing 1-2 years to open.
